Roles and Responsibilities: Directors

The work of the foundation is simple: seek funds and grant those funds to others.

During the school year, the Foundation will raise funds to provide teaching grants and to direct resources towards supporting the excellence of LISD. With the status of the current economy, the Foundation will need to be innovative and creative in raising funds to sustain the prominent spirit that the Foundation has created.

Each board member must be committed to the mission of the Lindale ISD Education Foundation and involved to make it a success. Basic responsibilities of board members are outlined below:

- The Education Foundation's primary source of revenue is through individual donors that feel as strongly as we do about getting tools into the hands of LISD students to grow and learn. As a director, members are asked to find, solicit, and explain the benefits of the foundation and collect donations.
- The Board of Directors will conduct a regular meeting each month for no longer than 1 hour and 15 minutes. **Attendance at meetings is extremely important.**
- Board members will also be asked to serve as leaders of the organization and express the organization's value and importance to the community.
- Board members will be asked to participate on various committees.
- Board members should participate in the fundraising activities of the organization.
- Board members should contribute resources to the organization.
